

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GENIUS-20 EXAM

1. Genius-20 Exam will be held on 30th January, 2022 (Sunday) for student moving into class 9, 10, 11, 12 Maths & 12 Bio.
2. Genius-20 Exam for Class 9th is meant for candidates who are presently studying in Class 8th and are moving to Class 9th in the next session; and likewise it can be understood how it is for Class 10th, 11th and 12th.
3. Genius-20 Exam has 5 free seats with 100% Free Education facility* for each class category. This means top 5 performers of the exam applying for class 9th category will be eligible for 100% Free Education for one year; and likewise it will be for rest of the class categories.

*However, a candidate needs to score a minimum of 70% marks to be eligible for 100% Free Education.

*100% Free Education Seat is non-transferrable. If a particular candidate decides not to avail the facility then that seat is NOT transferred to the next candidate on the merit list.

4. Genius-20 100% Free Education facility is applicable ONLY for 1 year for any class category. A student needs to qualify for a free education seat in the next session once again by appearing in Genius-20 exam all afresh through a new application form.
5. 100% Free Education for Class 9th means 100% Freeship on Catjee Fee plus 100% Freeship on School Fee*. You need to submit a refundable caution money amount of Rs 10,000 for availing the benefits.
100% Free Education for Class 10th means 100% Freeship on Catjee Fee plus 100% Freeship on School Fee*. You need to submit a refundable caution money amount of Rs 10,000 for availing the benefits.
100% Free Education for Class 11th means 100% Freeship on Catjee Fee plus 100% Freeship on School Fee* plus 100% freeship on hostel and fooding. You need to submit a refundable caution money amount of Rs 10,000 for availing the benefits.
100% Free Education for Class 12th means 100% Freeship on Catjee Fee plus 100% Freeship on School Fee* plus 100% freeship on hostel and fooding. You need to submit a refundable caution money amount of Rs 10,000 for availing the benefits.

NOTE: 100% Freeship on School Fee is applicable only if the candidate joins one of the CATJEE School Integrated Programs. More details on this can be achieved from CATJEE enquiry office.

6. There will be 50 questions in total in the question paper.
7. The duration of the exam is 1 hour 30 minutes.
8. Details of subjects and number of questions in the question paper:
For Class 9th moving students: Maths: 25 questions; Physics: 9 questions; Chemistry: 8 questions; Biology: 8 questions
For Class 10th moving students: Maths: 25 questions; Physics: 9 questions; Chemistry: 8 questions; Biology: 8 questions
For Class 11th moving students: Maths: 15 questions; Biology: 15 questions; Physics: 10 questions; Chemistry: 10 questions

For Class 12th (Maths Group) moving students: Physics: 17 questions; Chemistry: 17 questions; Maths: 16 questions

For Class 12th (Bio group) moving students: Physics: 17 questions; Chemistry: 17 questions; Biology: 16 questions

9. Genius-20 Exam Date and Time Slots:

Exam date For Class 9th, & 10th , 11th , 12th Moving Students: 30th January, 2022

Time Slot for Class 9th & 10th is from – 10:30am to 12.00 Afternoon

And Time Slot for Class 11th & 12th is from – 2:30pm to 04.00pm

10. Form filling procedure:

Offline Form Filling: A physical form for Genius-20 Exam can be purchased from CATJEE office, Mahmoorganj, Varanasi on payment of Rs 100. Completely filled up form has to be then submitted at the CATJEE reception and then Exam Admit card will be issued which will clearly carry information about exam date; roll number and the exam time slot.

Online Form Filling: A candidate can apply for the Genius-20 Exam online by visiting the website www.catjee.in. On the homepage, a banner of Genius-20 exam is visible containing a button "Click Here". Clicking on the button (hyperlink) will take the candidate to the online form. Fill the essentials and pay Rs 100 online through credit card/debit card/net banking/UPI. As soon as the payment is done, a confirmation page will appear on the screen. After filling the online form, you can also save a copy of Completed Application Form and Exam Admit Card in pdf format. The admit card will contain exam date, exam roll number and time slot clearly. In case of any confusion during online form filling, please contact 9580504563 / 9696961900.

If you have filled the form online, please remember to carry a valid photo Id proof along with the admit card on the day of exam.

11. Each question in the question paper carries 1 mark. There is no negative marking for any question.

12. SPECIAL MARKING RULE FOR CLASS 11TH MOVING STUDENTS:

Class 11th moving students will have a special marking and ranking rule. There will be 50 questions in their paper – Physics 10; Chemistry 10; Maths 15; Bio 15. Each 11th moving student will answer all 50 questions compulsorily. It does not matter whether a candidate is Maths group aspirant or a Bio group aspirant. Each candidate will answer all 50 questions. However, independent ranking will be done based on the candidate's PCM marks and PCB marks.

A PCM ranklist will be generated out of 35 marks and another PCB ranklist will be generated out of 35 marks. Independent scholarship scheme will be applicable on both rank lists. The ranking and scholarship of PCM rank list will be applicable on the Maths group aspirants and that of PCB rank list will be applicable on the Bio group aspirants. Both the rank lists will have no connection with the other. The benefits of one will not be applicable on the other. One candidate can avail the benefits of only one rank list at a time. Choosing one will automatically cancel the benefits of the other rank list.

13. CASH REWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS BASED ON GENIUS-20 EXAM:

Cash Rewards:

There will be cash rewards based on the performance in Genius- 20 exam for each class category. The details of the same are mentioned as under:

For Class 9th Moving Students: Rank 1 : Rs. 5000;
Rank 2 : Rs. 3000;
Rank 3 : Rs. 1000;
Rank 4-10 : Rs. 500 each

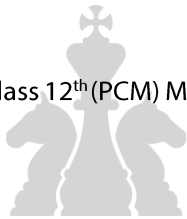

Special Scholarships based on Genius-20 Exam:

There are special scholarships and fee rebates based on the performance of the students in the Genius-20 Exam. There are no pre-defined parameters for deciding those scholarships. It is completely based on the analysis of the performance of the students in the exam on that specific day.

Note:

The identity and eligibility of a candidate will be doubly-verified before providing any benefit based on Genius-20 Exam like cash reward or any special scholarship/fee-waiver.

- 14.** The minimum qualifying marks in Genius-20 Exam for taking admission in any class is as under:
 - For Class 8th Moving students: 20/50
 - For Class 9th Moving students: 20/50
 - For Class 10th Moving students: 20/50
 - For Class 11th PCM Group Moving students: 12/35
 - For Class 11th PCB Group Moving students: 12/35
 - For Class 12th PCM Group Moving students: 20/50
 - For Class 12th PCB Group Moving students: 20/50
- 15.** Scoring qualifying marks in Genius-20 Exam makes a candidate eligible to take admission in a particular class. The candidate is, however, free to write the General Admission Test (GAT) one more time to be held April 2022 onwards to improve his/her score or to try for better scholarships/ fee waivers. Appearing in GAT is not compulsory at all if a candidate has qualifying marks in Genius-20 exam.
- 16.** The candidate needs to fill up an independent admission form worth Rs 600 to confirm his/her admission. The Genius-20 Application form of Rs 100 makes the candidate eligible to write the Genius-20 exam only. It does not confirm his/her admission in any course.
