



WHAT IS GENIUS-20?

Genius-20 is a special philanthropic project of **CATJEE** aimed at recognizing meritorious students through a high-end talent recognition examination which guarantees a student completely free-of-cost preparation of JEE (Main & Advanced)/NEET by the professionally equipped and specialized faculty of **CATJEE**. Through Genius-20 exam, the total amount of scholarship distributed to students is estimated to be more than **2 Crores** in terms of freeships & scholarships in **CATJEE** fee, school fee & hostel fee (lodging & fooding).

STEPS TO APPEAR IN GENIUS-20 EXAM

To appear in the Genius-20 exam, a candidate has to purchase an application form worth Rs.100/- and the duly filled form is to be submitted to get the admit card of the exam. This form filling process can be done either in offline mode or in online mode as explained below:

OFFLINE FORM FILLING: A physical application form for Genius-20 exam can be purchased from **CATJEE** office, Mahmoorganj, Varanasi on payment of Rs 100/-. Completely filled up application form along with a photocopy of Aadhaar card of the candidate is to be submitted at the **CATJEE** reception and then the exam admit card will be issued which will carry information about exam date, roll number and the exam time slot. **it is mandatory to carry a valid photo Id proof (preferably Aadhaar card) along with the admit card on the day of exam.**

ONLINE FORM FILLING: A candidate can apply for the Genius-20 exam online by visiting the website www.catjee.in. On the homepage, a banner of Genius-20 exam is visible containing a button “**Click Here to Apply Online**”. Clicking on the button (hyperlink) will take the candidate to the online application form. Fill all the required essentials and pay Rs. 100/- online through credit card/debit card/net banking/UPI. As soon as the payment is done, a page will appear containing two buttons “**Download Application Form**” and “**Download Admit Card**”. By clicking these buttons, the candidate can save a copy of the completed application form and exam admit card in pdf format. It is advisable to take a print-out of the admit card. The admit card will contain exam date, exam roll number and time slot. In case of any confusion during online form filling, please contact 9580504563 / 9627973000. **If a candidate has filled the form online, then it is mandatory to carry a valid photo Id proof (preferably Aadhaar card) along with the print-out of the admit card on the day of exam.**

GENIUS-20 EXAM DETAILS

1. **Genius-20 Exam Date:** 21st January, 2024 (Sunday)
2. **Genius-20 Exam Time Slots:**
For students moving to classes 9th & 10th : 10:30 am to 12.00 noon.
For students moving to classes 11th (PCM & PCB) & 12th (PCM & PCB) : 2:30 pm to 04.00 pm
3. The duration of the exam is 1 hour 30 minutes.
4. There will be total 50 questions in the question paper.
5. Each Question carries 1 mark. There is no negative marking for wrong answers or questions left un-attempted.

7. Special Marking Rule For Students Moving To Class 11th:

Candidates who are presently studying in class 10th in the current session 2023-24 and are moving to class 11th (PCM/PCB) in the next session (2024-25) will have a special marking and ranking rule. There will be 50 questions in their exam papers as per following distribution: Physics – 10, Chemistry – 10, Math – 15, Bio – 15. Each 11th moving student is supposed to answer all 50 questions compulsorily, irrespective of whether a candidate is an aspirant of PCM group or PCB group.

There will be three independent rank lists based on the candidate's (i) PCM marks (*out of 35 marks*) (ii) PCB marks (*out of 35 marks*) (iii) PCMB marks (*out of 50 marks*). Independent scholarship schemes will be applicable only on PCM & PCB rank lists. The ranking and scholarship of PCM rank list will be applicable for a candidate if he/she opts for PCM group in class 11th. Similarly, the ranking and scholarship of PCB rank list will be applicable for a candidate if he/she opts for PCB group in class 11th. Both the rank lists will be treated independent with no connection with the other. The benefits of one will not be applicable on the other. One candidate can avail the benefits of only one rank list at a time. Choosing one will automatically cancel the benefits of the other rank list.

There will be independent cash rewards to top 10 students of each category, that is, PCM, PCB & PCMB rank lists.

RESULT ANNOUNCEMENT:** The detailed result of Genius-20 exam conducted on 21st January 2024 will be announced by 31st January 2024 on the notice boards in CATJEE campus and on the website www.catjee.in. the same result will also be shared with each applicant through SMS on the registered mobile numbers.
- 9. SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIPS BASED ON GENIUS-20 EXAM:** In addition to 100% freeships, there are special scholarships and fee rebates based on the performance of the students in the Genius-20 exam. There are no pre-defined parameters for deciding those scholarships. It is completely based on the analysis of the performance of the students in the exam on that specific day.
- 10. CASH REWARDS BASED ON GENIUS-20 EXAM:** There will be cash rewards based on the performance in Genius- 20 exam for each class category. The details of the same are mentioned as under:

Note: The identity and eligibility of a candidate will be doubly-verified before providing any benefit based on Genius-20 exam like cash reward or any special scholarship/fee-waiver.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GENIUS-20 EXAM

- Genius-20 exam will be held on 21st January, 2024 (Sunday) for students moving to classes 9th, 10th, 11th Math (Engineering), 11th Bio (Medical), 12th Math (Engineering) & 12th Bio (Medical).
- Genius-20 exam for class 9th is meant for candidates who are presently studying class 8th in session 2023-24 and are moving to class 9th in the next session (2024-25).
 - Genius-20 exam for class 10th is meant for candidates who are presently studying class 9th in session 2023-24 and are moving to class 10th in the next session (2024-25).
 - Genius-20 exam for class 11th (both PCM & PCB) is meant for candidates who are presently studying class 10th in session 2023-24 and are moving to class 11th (PCM/PCB) in the next session (2024-25).
 - Genius-20 exam for class 12th (both PCM & PCB) is meant for candidates who are presently studying in class 11th (PCM / PCB) in session 2023-24 and are moving to class 12th (PCM/PCB) in the next session (2024-25).
- Genius-20 exam has 5 free seats with 100% free education facility for each class category.
- The top 5 performers of each class category (students moving to classes 9th, 10th, 11th Math, 11th Bio, 12th Math & 12th Bio) will be eligible for 100% free education for 1 year (one academic session). Irrespective of the rank attained in Genius-20 exam, the benefits of 100% free education will be applicable only if a candidate has scored minimum 70% marks.
- The 100% free education facility is applicable only for one academic session. To avail the free education facility in the successive academic sessions, a student needs to apply for Genius-20 exam of the next session afresh and claim a 100% free education seat.
- 100% free education seat is non-transferrable. If a particular candidate decides not to avail the free education facility, then the benefits are not-transferrable to the next candidate on the merit list.

This means that if a student in the top 5 list who has been awarded the 100% freeship does not take admission in **CATJEE**, then that will NOT mean that the next student on the merit list will be eligible for the freeship category.

7. 100% free education for students moving to classes 9th & 10th means 100% freeship on **CATJEE** fee plus 100% freeship on School fee.

100% free education for students moving to class 11th (Math or Bio), class 12th (Math or Bio) means 100% freeship on **CATJEE** fee plus 100% freeship on School fee plus 100% freeship on Hostel fee (fooding & lodging)

NOTE :(i) 100% freeship on School fee is applicable only if the candidate joins **CATJEE** School Integrated Program. Hence if a candidate, who has qualified for 100% free education seat, joins **CATJEE** coaching program then he/she is entitled to get freeship on **CATJEE** fee and hostel fee (if applicable) only.

(ii) 100% freeship on Hostel fee is applicable only if the candidate joins a **CATJEE** governed hostel.

8. The allocation of free education seat in **CATJEE** or in the Catjee affiliated school or either in the **CATJEE** governed Hostel is completely dependent on the availability of seat. Hence, it is highly advisable to the candidates (who have been awarded 100% free education) to book their seats as soon as Genius-20 exam result is announced.
9. All disputes are subject to Varanasi jurisdiction only.

TO TAKE ADMISSION IN CATJEE

1. The candidate needs to fill up an independent admission form worth Rs 600 to confirm his/her admission. The Genius-20 application form of Rs 100 makes the candidate eligible to write the Genius-20 exam only. It does not confirm his/her admission in any course.
2. Scoring qualifying marks in Genius-20 Exam makes a candidate eligible to take admission in a particular class. The candidate is, however, free to write the General Admission Test (GAT) one more time to be held March 2024 onwards to improve his/her score or to try for better scholarships/fee waivers. Appearing in GAT is not compulsory at all if a candidate has achieved qualifying marks in Genius-20 exam.
3. Each candidate eligible for 100% free education through Genius-20 exam needs to submit a refundable caution money amount of Rs. 10,000 for availing the benefits.
4. Once a candidate deposits the caution money and blocks his/her seat no part thereof is refundable on the basis of admission cancellation. It is to be noted that the caution money is refunded after successful completion of a particular academic session.
